## 2005 Senior Open Tournament Rules – Lubbock Texas

- 1) **Entry is open to all ABC / WIBC sanctioned bowlers, men and women, who have reached age 55 or older by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005. Tournament will be ABC / WIBC sanctioned and conducted in accordance to the rules and regulations of these organizations**
- 2) **Tournament will consist of Team, Singles, and Optional All-Events. Teams will consist of 4 members and must have at least one member of the opposite sex bowling on the team.**
- 3) **This is a handicapped event, Team, Singles, and All-Events will be handicapped 90% of 220.**
- 4) **Entry Fees - \$9.00 Per Event (Linage and Expense \$3.75, Prize Fee 5.25) - Optional All-Events fee of \$2.00. Prize fund will be returned 100% after deducting cost of championship awards. Prize fund Ratio: At least 1 Prize for every 8 entries in Team and Singles Events – At least 1 Prize for every 10 Entries in All-Events**
- 5) **Entry Closing Dates – Entry must be received no later than Wednesday June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005. Full payment must accompany entry. DO NOT SEND CASH. Check, Money order, or Bank Drafts accepted. Should a check be returned for insufficient funds the bowlers scores may be disqualified. A fee of \$25.00 will be assessed to all returned checks.**
- 6) **Divisions – There will be divisions for men and women as follows – Aged based divisions will be based on the bowlers age as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005**

- 7) **Entering Average**
  - a. Entrants will use their highest sanctioned ABC / WIBC average of 21 games or more from the previous winter leagues listed in the 2003 – 2004 yearbook
  - b. If entrant does not have a qualifying winter league average, entrant may use highest current season average of 18 games or more. Average verifications may be submitted the day bowled. Verifications must be signed by league or association secretary.
  - c. Entrants without a qualifying average **MUST BOWL SCRATCH** with an average of 220
  - d. **IT IS THE BOWLERS** responsibility to verify the accuracy of the submitted average. If the submitted average is lower than the actual average thus resulting in more handicap the scores bowled under the submitted average will be **DISQUALIFIED**. Placement and prize earnings will be based on the submitted average.
  - e. ABC / WIBC rule 319a (2), 319d and 319e will be waived for this event
  - f. Averages for Prize paying places will be verified with Association Secretaries
- 8) **Multiple Entries –**
  - a. **Team** - Unlimited team entries accepted. Not more than two (2) players on the same team can place more than once in the prize fund list. Bowlers bowling in more than one Team Event must count first team scores toward All-Events scores.
  - b. **Singles** – Bowler may bowl in Singles multiple times. Bowlers first scores in singles will count towards All-Events totals. Bowler can only place one time in prize list
- 9) **This event** is being hosted by the Lubbock Bowling Association and the Lubbock Women’s Bowling Association. Local Association fees for ABC /WIBC are being waived for members outside of the LBA / LWBA jurisdiction. LBA / LWBA members may compete and qualify for prizes.
- 10) **Tournament Games** cannot be re-bowled except as authorized by tournament management when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device
- 11) **Tournament Management** will have authority to decide on any other matters pertaining to the operation of this tournament not covered by tournament rules.
